In 2008, 2 specialist bathrooms were installed in the new build Mailand School in the town of Strømmen near Oslo.

Mailand offers upper secondary education and training programs to young people aged 16 - 19 years and is able to accommodate up to 720 students from the district.

Each year, Mailand welcomes a number of young people with multiple disabilities and varying degrees of dependency.



Challenge
